


Crystal Field

53% cotton, 38% wool, 9% nylon

Crystal Field is a highly structured, dense épinglé upholstery textile. It is reminiscent of looking at a patchwork of fields from above: as you get closer to it, patterns within patterns are revealed, showing intriguing depths reminiscent of crystals.

The design combines geometric shapes constructed from dots, which break down into different patterns. These are created by using looped yarns that, through combining different colors, create the illusion of stitching.



Forest Nap95% wool, 5% nylon

Woollen *Forest Nap* is a simple upholstery textile. Constructed with a plain weave, it can be described as the base textile in the Akira Minagawa collection and is particularly suited to cover large surfaces.

Forest Nap comes in an array of colors, such as understated natural hues.
