Two chairs from the MARUNI COLLECTION have recently been put on display in the Toshiba Gallery as examples of Japan's outstanding craftsmanship and uniquely delicate sensibilities.

The V&A has over 140 galleries, the majority of which are permanent displays that can be enjoyed free of charge. The beautifully designed cafeteria and museum shop are also extremely popular among visitors.
